Simple Present

I go to school every day.
I don't go to school every day.
Do you go to school every day?
Where do you go every day?

He goes to school every day.
He doesn't go to school every day.
Does he go to school every day?
Where does he go every day?

Simple Past

I went to school yesterday.
I didn't go to school yesterday.
Did you go to school yesterday?
Where did you go yesterday?

He went to school yesterday.
He didn't go to school yesterday.
Did he go to school yesterday?
Where did he go yesterday?

Simple Future

I will go to school tomorrow.
I won't go to school tomorrow.
Will you go to school tomorrow?
Where will you go tomorrow?

He will go to school tomorrow.
He won't go to school tomorrow.
Will he go to school tomorrow?
Where will he go tomorrow?

PERFECT TENSES	Present Perfect	I have done my homework. I haven't done my homework. Have you done your homework? What have you done?	He has done his homework. He hasn't done his homework. Has he done his homework? What has he done?
	Past Perfect	I had done my homework yesterday. I hadn't done my homework yesterday. Had you done your homework yesterday? What had you done yesterday?	He had done his homework. He hadn't done his homework. Had he done his homework? What had he done?
	Future Perfect	I will have done my homework. I won't have done my homework Will you have done your homework? What will you have done?	He will have done his homework. He won't have done his homework. Will he have done his homework? What will he have done?
