❖ **HOW MANY:**

We use it to ask questions about the quantity of a countable noun.
How many students are there in the class?
There are eighteen students in the class.

❖ **HOW MUCH:**

We use it to ask questions about the quantity of an uncountable noun.
How much cheese would you like?
Not much.

❖ **MANY:**

In general, we use «**many**» with countable nouns.
Are there **many** apples in the basket? No, there aren't **many**.

❖ **MUCH:**

In general, we use «**much**» with uncountable nouns.
Is there **much** food left? No, there isn't **much**.

We usually use much and many with questions (?) and negatives (-)
